The camp continues to offer a well-rounded, immersive learning experience combining theoretical foundations with hands-on technical training preparing participants for future opportunities in the evolving digital job market.



Enriching Experience: Integrated Recreational Activities

To balance academic rigor with creative expression and personal development, the camp features a diverse programme of recreational activities. Students engaged in pottery painting, accessory making, mirror art, a precision-shooting marathon, and the immersive 'Escape the Virus' maze. Boys also enjoyed specialized activities such as LEGO car racing and solving crime-themed puzzles. These sessions promote teamwork, creativity, and social interaction helping students' recharge while supporting their personal growth alongside their cybersecurity learning.

Ethical Hacking: Training Digital Defenders

Students continue to advance in their cybersecurity journey, building on foundational knowledge while diving deeper into advanced topics. From understanding the core principles of digital safety to analysing common web-based threats and how to defend against them, the programme equips participants with both technical skills and strategic awareness. In one of the camp's standout sessions, educational advocate Dr. Abdulrahman Al-Harami emphasized the importance of helping students recognise their own potential and understand the opportunities available in this fast-evolving field. He noted that true impact doesn't come from learning alone it comes from applying that knowledge meaningfully. Dr. Al-Harami also highlighted the critical role of families, particularly fathers, in nurturing values and supporting young learners as they prepare to become tomorrow's digital defenders.

Cybersecurity Learning: Building Depth and Confidence

As the second cohort progresses through the programme, participants continue to explore both foundational and advanced cybersecurity topics. Training begins with core concepts that establish a strong understanding of cyberspace. Students then dive into the intricacies of web security—learning to recognize common online threats and respond with effective countermeasures. The journey extends into the study of networks, systems, and their protection mechanisms. Each module is carefully designed to develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills, preparing students to address digital threats with confidence.
