## The Closing Ceremony: A Moment of Pride

Held on Thursday, August 7, 2025, the closing ceremony brought together representatives from the National Cyber Security Agency, the Ministry of Education and Higher Education, the Ministry of Sports and Youth, alongside partners, speakers, and parents. Among the distinguished guests who honored the event with their presence were Eng. Abdulrahman bin Ali Al-Fraihid Al-Malki, President of the National Cyber Security Agency; Mr. Ahmed Mohammed Al-Mutawa Al-Hammadi, Director General of the Agency; Dr. Abdulrahman Al-Harami; and Mr. Salem Al-Marri, Deputy Director General of Qatar Science and Technology Secondary School. The event featured an exhibition of student projects, showcasing practical solutions to real digital challenges. A panel discussion with select students reflected on how the camp shaped their educational outlook. The ceremony also included the recognition of partner organizations, guest speakers, and the announcement of the top cybersecurity projects developed during the program which are the, Safe clicks team won first place, the cyber lab team came in second, and the AntiPass team secured third place in the 13–14 age category. In the 15–17 age category, the kashifs team won first place, followed by the Nmap GUI Tool team in second place, and the HUB 0101 team in third place This ceremony wasn't just the end of the camp; it was the culmination of an intensive four week educational journey and an opportunity to spotlight the rising talent that will shape the future of cybersecurity in Qatar.

## Investing in Qatar's Youth: A Look to the Future

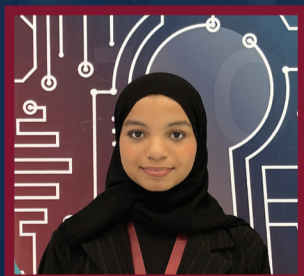

"Our project is a website we designed to protect individuals with special needs. We noticed that this group is often more susceptible to cyber-attacks, making them an easy target for hackers. That's why we created this website to help them protect their data and use the internet more safely. We divided the site into dedicated sections that suit the needs of each group, whether they have visual, auditory, or cognitive impairments. Each section has a specific interface that shows the user what to do and what to avoid. If the system suspects an attempted hack or suspicious activity, it immediately issues an alert to the user via a ringing sound, vibration, or a visual warning, depending on the type of disability to enable them to take appropriate action quickly."
