A Fitting Finale to a Twenty-Day Journey



The National Cyber Security Agency celebrated the closing of the third edition of the Cybersecurity Youth Summer Camp, in the presence of H.E. Eng. Abdulrahman bin Ali Al-Farahid Al-Malki, President of the National Cyber Security Agency, and H.E. Dr. Ibrahim bin Saleh Al-Nuaimi, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Education and Higher Education, alongside parents and participants, with participant Hamad Al-Mahshadi serving as the ceremony's MC. The event looked back on a twenty-day journey undertaken by 400 participants, combining theoretical knowledge, hands-on practice, technical challenges, and field visits, culminating in graduation projects that reflected the skills and expertise they had gained — a journey that began with curiosity and passion and ended with real capabilities preparing this generation for a future full of opportunity in cybersecurity.

From Gaming Passion to National Responsibility

A group of participants performed a play under this title, shedding creative light on the importance of awareness around digital risks. The play told the story of "Nasser," a student deceived by an online "friend" he met through a video game, who convinced him to download a pirated game from an unofficial website using his father's saved card details, leading to unauthorized charges that forced the family to turn to the Cybercrime Department. The investigation revealed that this "friend" was in fact a hacker who had exploited trust to entrap his victim. The performance closed with Nasser's realization that a mistake isn't shameful, and his resolve to become a shield for his nation. The performance earned praise from attendees for delivering an important message through a creative format, reaffirming that awareness is the starting point and knowledge is the first line of defense.

The ceremony celebrated the winners of the Consultation Corner competition Best Hacker title, along with the camp's Encouragement Award, as well as the winning teams for Best Graduation Project across both age categories.
